AMBUCS TO HOLD LUNCHEON WITH KRISTY CURRY FOR AREA BASKETBALL COACHES

LUBBOCK, Texas (October 8, 2008) – The Caprock chapter of the Lubbock Ambucs will host a luncheon for area coaches Thursday, October 9th from 12:00pm to 1:00pm at the Hub City Playground at Maxey Park, 24th Street and Quaker Avenue.

The purpose of the luncheon is to promote the 50th Annual Caprock Basketball Tournament, the proceeds from which are used to purchase AmTryke therapeutic tricycles and fund other projects of the Caprock Ambucs. Lady Raider Coach Kristy Curry will be at the luncheon to help promote the basketball tournament to coaches from Lubbock and the surrounding areas. Various administrators from the Lubbock Independent School District central office are expected to attend. Additionally, several AmTrykes will be given away.

National AMBUCS, Inc. is a non-profit service organization consisting of a diverse group of men and women who are dedicated to creating mobility and independence for people with disabilities. Members fulfill the organization's mission by performing various forms of community service, donating AmTryke therapeutic tricycles to individuals who are unable to ride traditional bikes, and awarding scholarships to therapists.

With the AmTryke therapeutic tricycle, individuals who are unable to operate a traditional bike can have the fun and freedom of riding a bike. These unique tricycles, which can be hand and/or foot operated, are designed to accommodate riders of all ages, sizes and varying degrees of physical limitations. Both physical and occupational therapists acknowledge the AmTryke tricycle's many therapeutic benefits, citing improved motor skills, strength development and self-esteem.
