



AMERICAN WINDMILL MUSEUM 1701 Canyon Lake Dr.

/ 806.747.8734 Visit the largest collection of windmills in the world at the American Windmill Museum. Visitors are immersed in the pioneering spirit of Lubbock, Texas, through exhibits and art including the 6,000-square-foot hand-painted mural titled Legacy of the Wind.

BUDDY HOLLY CENTER 1801 Crickets Ave. / 806.775.3560
This permanent exhibit is dedicated to the life and

music of rock 'n' roll legend, Buddy Holly. View memorabilia donated by family, friends and fans of Lubbock's favorite son, including the iconic Buddy Holly glasses found at the site of the airplane crash.

CAVIEL MUSEUM OF AFRICAN AMERICAN HISTORY

1719 Ave. A / 806.773.6046 This museum is named after the former owners of the building, Alfred and Billie Caviel, the first African American husband and wife to own and operate their own pharmacy in the U.S. See exhibits dedicated to celebrating art, culture and

identity with artwork from Africa and antiques donated by community members.



Nestled in Cactus Alley, Mano Negra is Lubbock's first
nano-brewery. Owner and Brewmaster Daniel Badillo first
concocted his brewed ale in his former home in Puerto
Rico. After deciding to move to Lubbock, the brewery

Lubbock community through delicious craft beers like
the house favorite, Guadalupe Peak.

CULTURAL DISTRICT With The Buddy Holly Hall of Performing Arts and Sciences and renowned art galleries including LHUCA and the Charles Adams Gallery, visitors are immersed in the emerging culture of Lubbock, Texas.

As art that takes form both on stage and on display, it's no wonder Lubbock boasts one of the first cultural districts designated in the Lone Star State!

BUSINESS DISTRICT The cornerstone of Lubbock's growth, history is preserved in the form of revitalized buildings and boutique hotels. Down the red brick-paved road of Broadway, the Cotton Court Hotel, designed to replicate a vintage cotton gin, pays homage to the roots that planted the city we know today. Local Chef Cameron West shares his version of "Hub City" fare at The West Table Kitchen & Bar; and Chef Finn Walter showcases the taste of the South Plains in each delectable menu item at The Nicolett.

Taste the Texas High Plains in each glass of vino perfectly paired with cuisine from the upscale bistro menu at Burklee Hill Vineyards (pictured left) located in the historic Kress Building. For those with a sweet tooth, stop by for an afternoon treat at Cakes by Marsha!

DEPOT ENTERTAINMENT DISTRICT Where Lubbock nights come to life, the Depot Entertainment District is the birthplace of many musicians we know and love today like the Josh Abbott Band and Flatland Cavalry.

Whether you prefer patio nights sipping Texas wine at McPherson Cellars, indulging in Spanish tapas at La Diosa Cellars, rocking out with a Chilton at the Blue Light or enjoying a show at the Cactus Theater, there is something for everyone. 


